Stop: Don't toss that broken brooch sitting in your jewelry box! Repurpose it into a hair accessory. You can glue it to a headband, hair comb or barrette. We especially love the look of this sparkly clip for weddings – talk about instant hair appeal. Here's how: Using a glue gun, dab a small amount of glue onto the top of a plain hair clip, then press the brooch into the glue to hold. It's that simple.
